Strategies for success include creating daily to-do lists, finding a private space to work and focus, and keeping an eye open for burnout.

Workers also need to realize that working from home is an adjustment that will take time to get used to, meaning goals and expectations need to be realistic. There are a lot of tips to be more productive while working from home, and it's important to consider which specific options are possible for each worker and company.

In reality, the real pitfall comes not in moments wasted, but extended. A task that takes an hour to complete doesn't seem like a bad use of time unless it's possible to complete the same task in half the time.

Many offices have found that daily video calls and check-ins allow the team to feel connected; a company culture is still possible to cultivate online via occasional non-work-related conversations, clear communication guidelines, and an overall show of trust. Though you may no longer be in the same building as the rest of your team members, the reliance on one another to get the job done is still very much there. Figuring out how to do that from a distance is often the biggest challenge while working from home.

Luckily, we no longer live in an age where we need to wait for snail mail or faxes to arrive before knowing what needs to be accomplished next. Some businesses, however, operate in a similar way while working remotely: multiple emails are sent out daily, documents are traded back and forth, and work can't move forward until everyone is on the same page.

Offices use various software tools, Cloud storage systems, and company organization rules to keep everything in its place. SaaS tools such as Slack, Trello, and Mockplus can help workers keep both their individual and team tasks straight.

Knowing exactly where everything is located is even more vital when a physical space such as an office isn't shared. Electronic files are easy to access, but they also need to be easy to locate.

When working remotely, a notepad can't be passed to a coworker, nor can documents be dropped off on a desk. Plenty of ways exist to communicate electronically, but sharing these types of forms requires the tedious task of typing up and digitizing what has already been created.

Optical Character Recognition, or OCR, is a software integrated into Lumin designed to recognize text in handwritten notes, scanned images, and photos.
